

## Fruitport High School Senior Scholars - Class of 2023



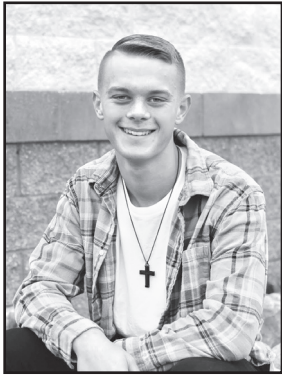

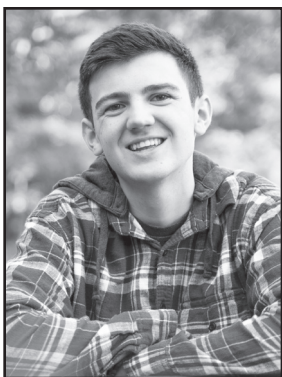
