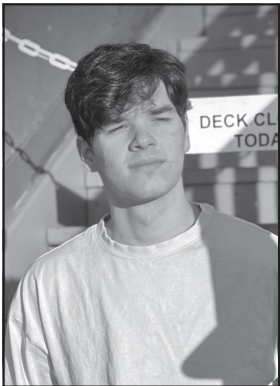
Nate Brown
